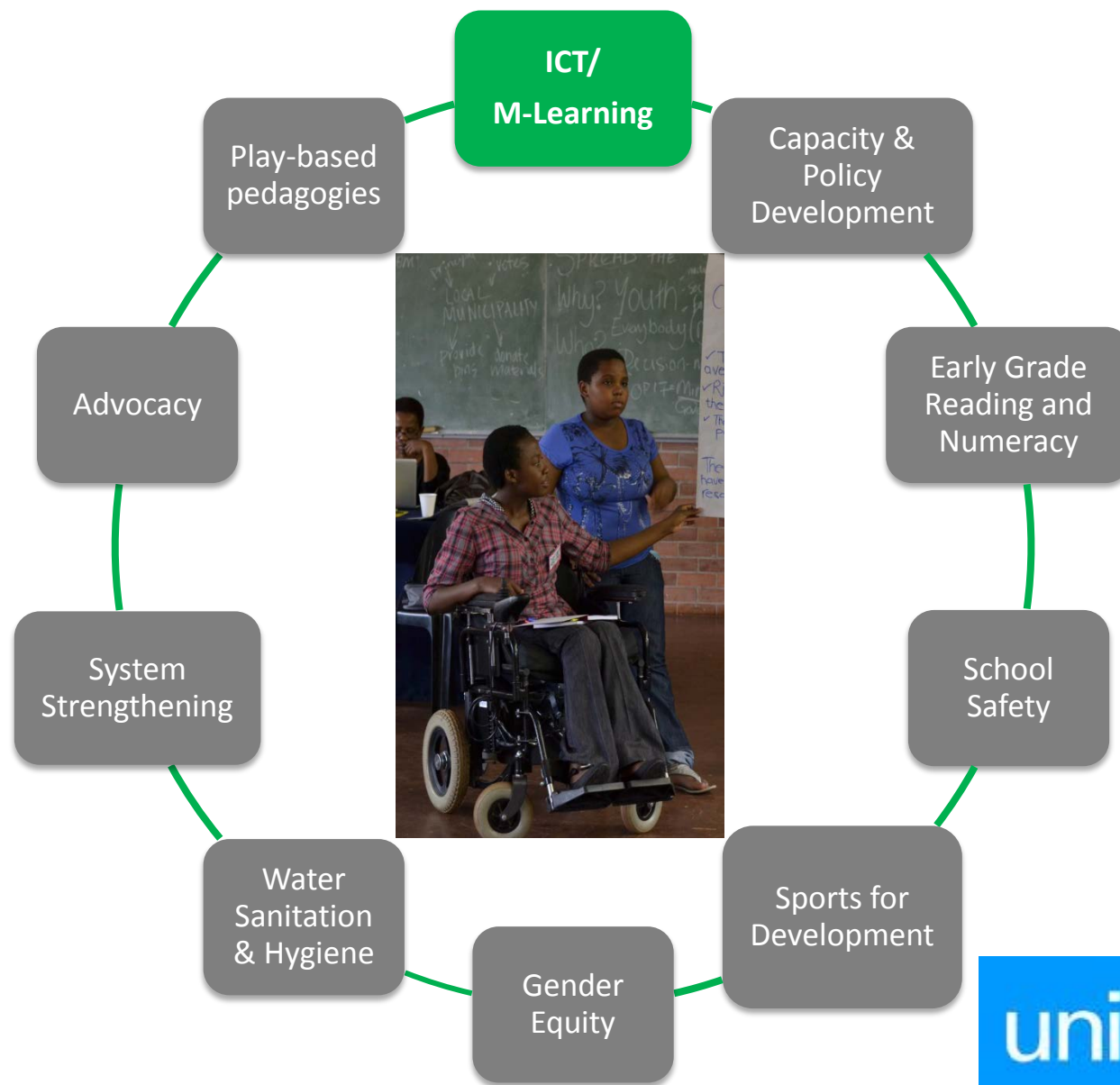
OUTCOME: Improved access to quality education for all boys and girls, and increased school retention, completion and achievement rates

To Address Barriers Related To

- Early experience – later life outcomes
- Internal inefficiency – school system/push-pull
- Inclusion: access, disability, violence/school safety
- Quality – performance; bimodal curve; weak teacher capacity
- Sub-national capacity, and accountability
- Assessment: frameworks, utility,
- ICT – and learning outcomes improvement
- Adolescent ‘mixes’: HIV, teen pregnancy, drugs

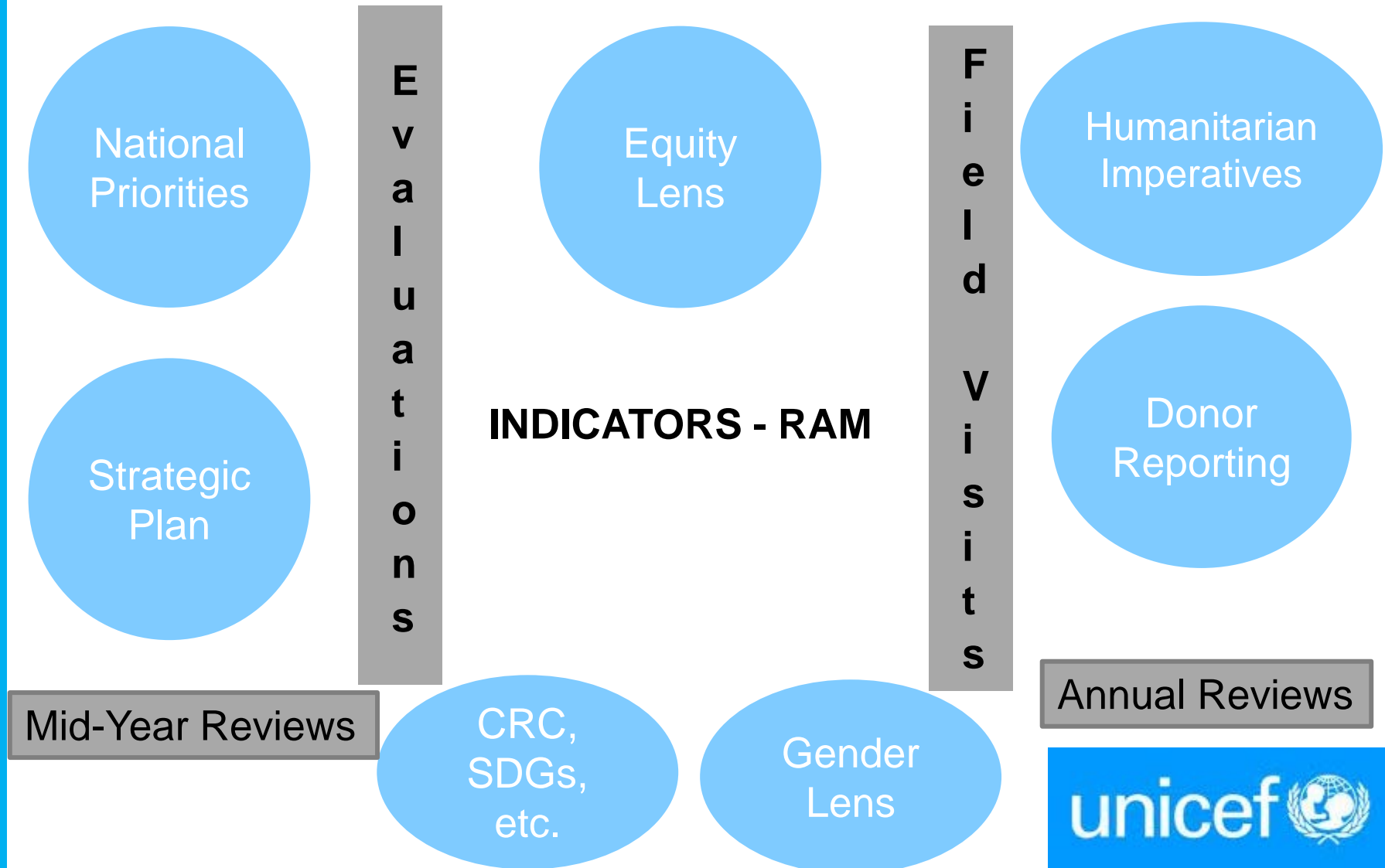


Around Ten Programme Elements

- Enable quicker assessment of results
- Support visualization of & open access to M&E data
- Satisfy CSO demands for transparency & accountability
- Supplement existing methods - a single method cannot cover all monitoring needs and requirements
